

# Sleepover Policy@PARADYS

- Sleepovers are not encouraged. MySpace will however permit sleepovers, in certain room types only, and only on a Friday and Saturday night.
- Residents MUST adhere to the following:
  - Residents with overdue rental accounts are not permitted to book a sleepover. Please settle any outstanding balances before requesting additional services.
  - Residents must inform MySpace of the sleepover by filling out the sleepover link provided.
  - Only one sleepover permitted per resident.
  - A charge of R500 (five hundred Rand) will be applied to the rental account for each night of the sleepover.
  - Failure to inform MySpace of the sleepover will result in an additional penalty of R500 (five hundred Rand) being charged to the rental account.
  - Sleepovers are not permitted in open shared rooms (Twin/Bunker) to ensure the comfort of roommates.
  - Consent from flatmates is required if staying in a shared unit (Duo/Trio/Crew). Failure to provide proof of consent will incur an additional fine.
  - MySpace does not encourage parents, mature relatives/friends to sleep over.
  - No Extended Partnerships: Moving in partners for extended periods is strictly prohibited, as outlined in the lease agreement, constituting a breach of contract.
- Any abuse of sleepovers by residents or their guests, or if MySpace receives any complains, sleepovers will be discontinued immediately.

# Sleepover Policy@DROSTDY & DORPSTREET

- Sleepovers are not encouraged. MySpace will however permit sleepovers, in certain room types only, and only on a Friday and Saturday night.
- Residents MUST adhere to the following:
  - Residents with overdue rental accounts are not permitted to book a sleepover. Please settle any outstanding balances before requesting additional services.
  - In the case of an emergency where a resident need to accommodate a guest during the week, the Resident should request approval in advance (3 business days prior) from MySpace Management via the WhatsApp number. Take note that MySpace reserves the right to decide weather the scenario can be deemed as an emergency sleepover or not.
  - Only one sleepover permitted per resident.
  - A charge of R500 (five hundred Rand) will be applied to the rental account for each night of the sleepover.
  - Failure to inform MySpace of the sleepover will result in an additional penalty of R500 (five hundred Rand) being charged to the rental account.
